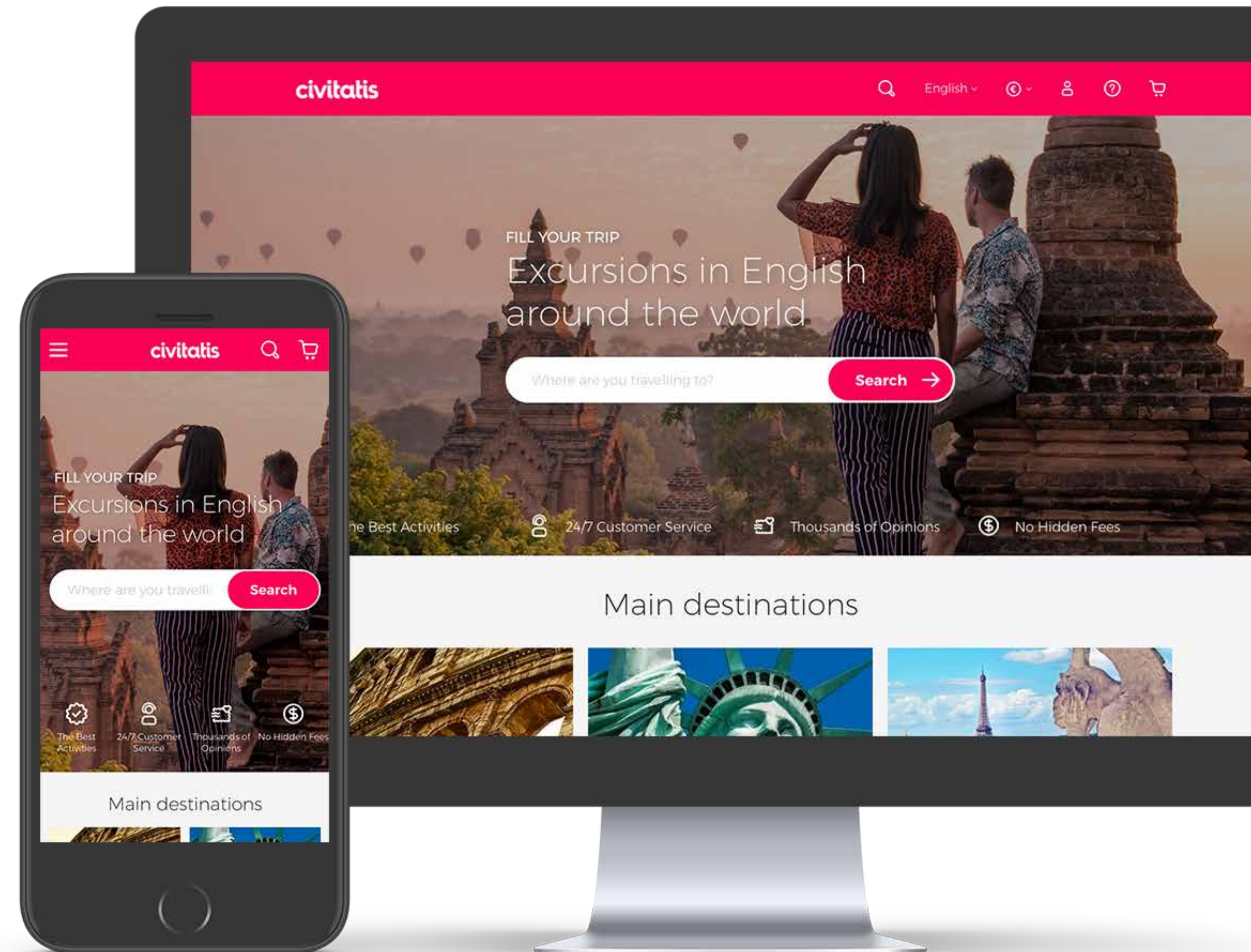

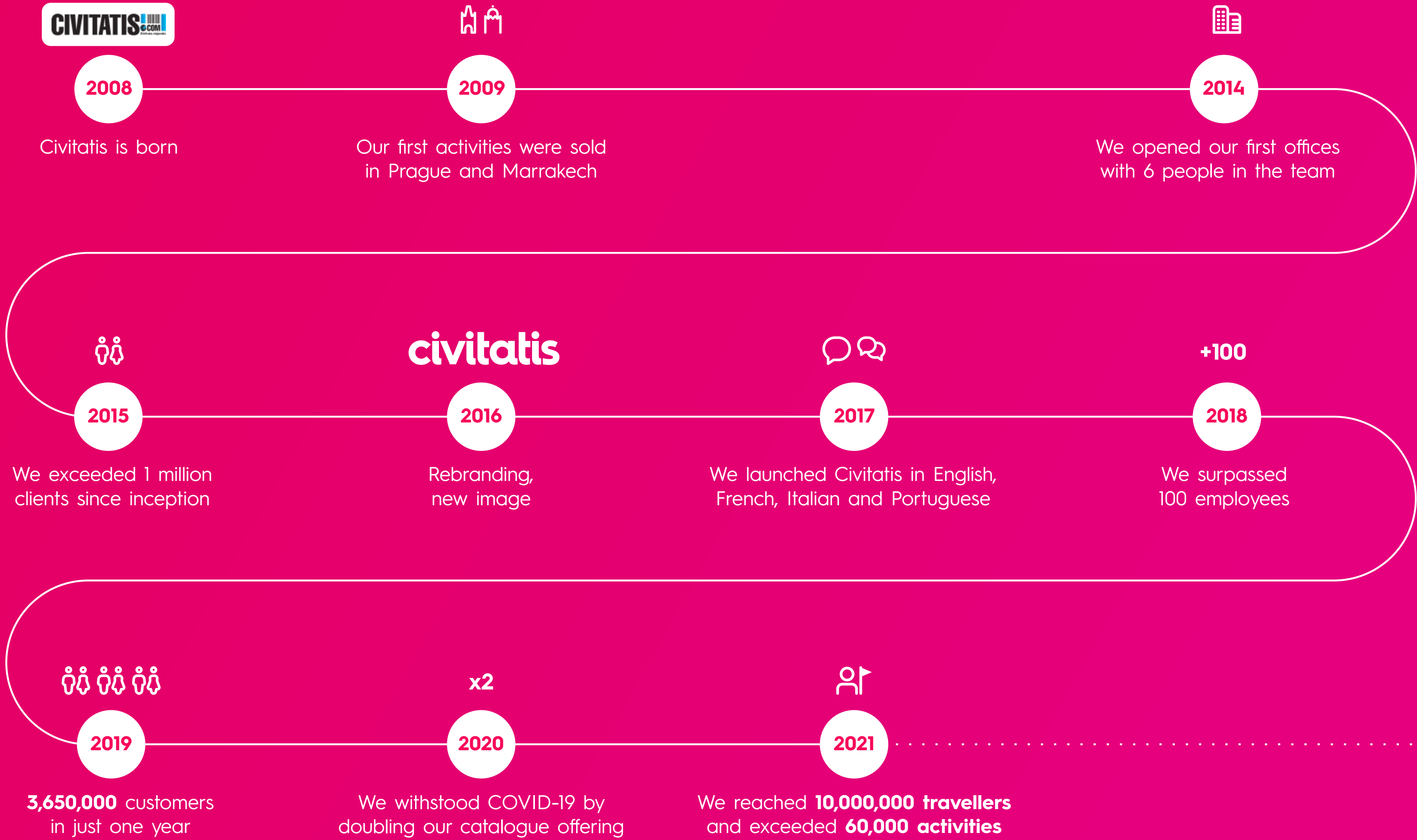
Civitatis was born in 2008 as a personal project for Alberto Gutiérrez Pascual, founder and current CEO of the company.

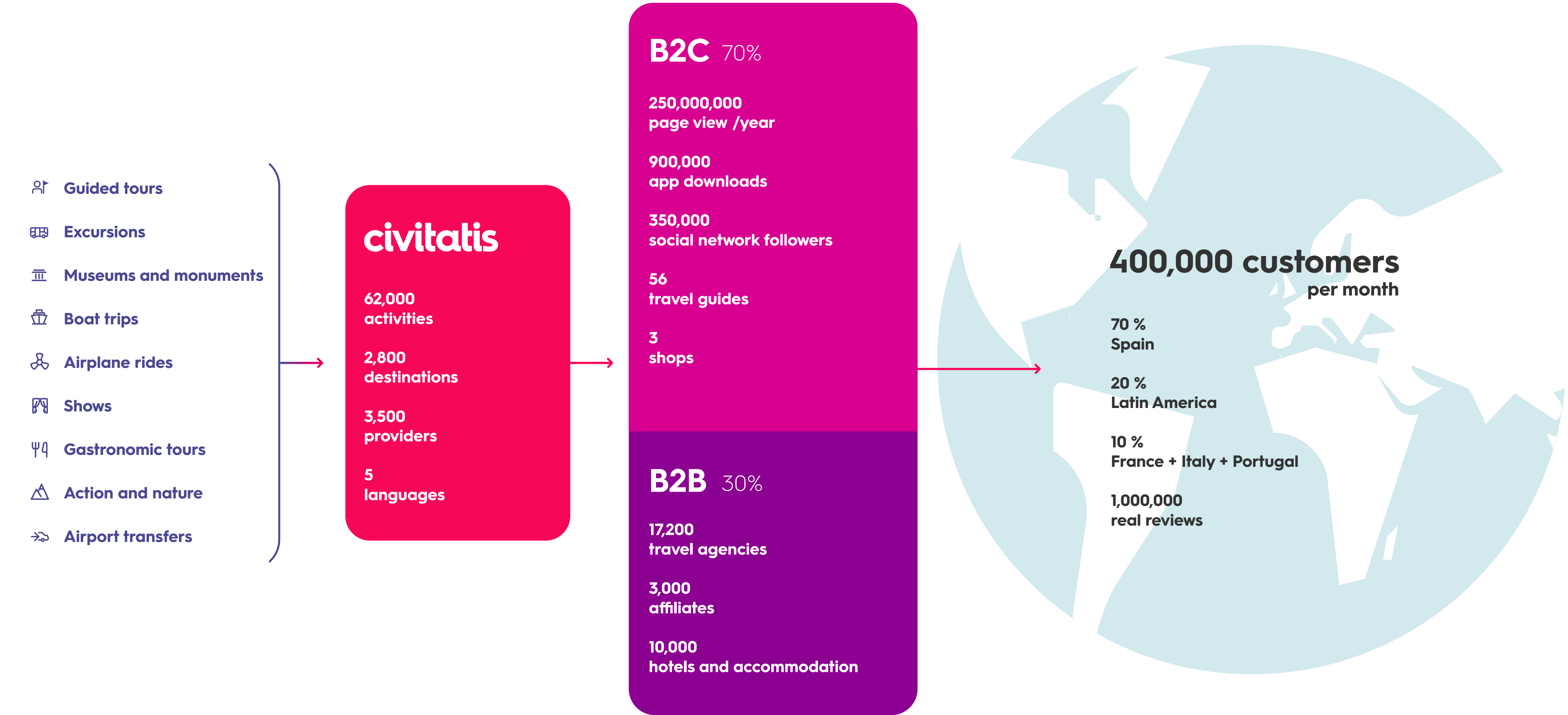
